Any rider who has qualified for either the ASPCA Maclay Finals or USEF Medal Finals/USEF Pony Medal Finals is not eligible to compete in the CCHSA Finals. Fences 2' for Smalls, 2'3" for Mediums and 2'6" for Larges.

Same specifications as the CCHSA Pony Medal but riders must be on horses. Fences 2'9" to 3'.

Same specifications as the CCHSA Pony Medal but riders must be amateurs mounted on horses. Fences 3'.

78. EPPHA JUNIOR LOW EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to all Juniors on horses or ponies. Ponies to jump 2', horses to jump 2'3". Rider may not cross enter into a class over 2'6", or have previously shown in any class over 2'6". Course will consist of eight or more fences with or without wings. Course must contain at least one change of direction, and one roll back. Each course will include a simple test (USEF tests 1-8). Class will be judged on hands, seat, lets, guidance and control.

Open to all adult amateur riders. Horses to jump 2'3". Riders may not have shown or show in any class over 2'6". Course and testing to be the same requirements as the Junior Medal above.

Note that several of our divisions have become "Opportunity Divisions". Riders in these divisions are exempt from USEF&USHJA Membership Fees, and will also be exempt from paying the USEF Federation Fees (but must still comply with the Drugs & Medication rules and are subject to drug testing). There are a few restrictions on the riders eligible to participate in this program, so see USEF Rule GR821 to make sure you are in compliance. In short: Riders may not have shown in any USEF rated division (at any time), horses may have. This is a great opportunity to welcome new riders to the world of recognized showing, and to introduce them to the USEF and USHJA!!

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entries made to Phone (908)-534-8833; Fax (908)-534-8843; email jackate@aol.com
2. Post entries will be accepted at no charge, but early entries are most appreciated.
3. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
4. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
5. The Wyndor Farm Horse Show, Wyndor Farm Inc., the Committee, Briarwood Farms Inc., or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
6. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
7. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
8. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class (es) or schooling deemed necessary.
10. Ties for first place will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
11. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
12. Horses must enter entire division to be eligible for prizemoney.
13. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
14. All pets must be leashed.
15. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
16. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
17. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection.
18. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**



ATTN EXHIBITORS: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but no limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooter, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.



REGARDING MEASUREMENTS: Should the veterinarian need to be called to the show for the purpose of measuring horses or ponies, the appointed time will be 10:00 a.m. Any and all necessary arrangements to have the veterinarian to the show specifically for measurements must be made by the Wednesday of the week before the show day, and must be made through the show office only at (908)-534-8833. Permanent Measurements cannot be made on a walk-in basis, of course Day Measurements are always available at any time.
